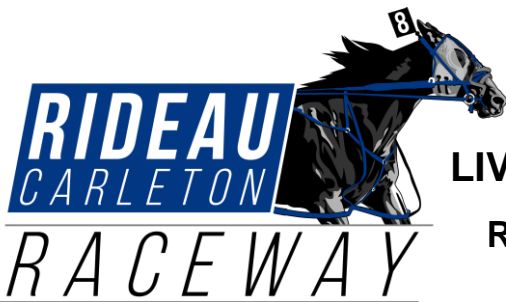

Favourites Foiled In Filly OSS Golds



One favourite found themselves defeated and the other disqualified in a pair of Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold divisions for three-year-old trotting fillies at Rideau Carleton Raceway on Sunday night (July 16).

In the \$100,400 first division, 6-5 choice Muscling Vegas had a first-over mountain to climb on tempo-setter Mass Hysteria (pictured above), who stayed resolute on the lead to win in 1:54.3.

Starting from the pylon post, Mass Hysteria secured command as Muscling Vegas took back to race fourth through a :27.2 first quarter. Mass Hysteria, meanwhile, moved uncontested to a :57.3 half, which readied her for Muscling Vegas's challenge up the backside. The favourite loomed to within a length of the lead by three-quarters in 1:26.1 but levelled off around the final turn while Mass Hysteria spun for home. She rolled to the finish a 2-3/4-length winner over HP Extra Ice, who closed for second, with second-over Believe U Me finishing third.

Kyle Bossence trains and co-owns [Mass Hysteria](#), a daughter of Muscle Mass, with Daniel Culp and William Pendleton. She now has won three races from 11 starts and banked \$244,408. Trevor Henry drove the \$11.20 winner.

While the favourite had too steep a climb in the first division, Climb The Pole in the \$101,300 second division ascended to first following a disqualification of 1-9 favourite Righteous Resolve, who cut the mile and crossed the line first in 1:54.1.

Righteous Resolve cleared command from Climb The Pole past a :27.3 first quarter and coasted through middle fractions of :56.3 and 1:25.2 before turning for home and crossing the beam 1-1/4 lengths in front of Climb The Pole. However, Righteous Resolve veered into the passing lane while on the lead swinging into the stretch, forcing her disqualification from first to second. Baroness Hill took third and Northern Demi finished fourth.

From the placing, [Climb The Pole](#) has now won five races from 10 starts and banked \$150,518. Carl Jamieson trains and co-owns the daughter of Kadabra with driver Jody Jamieson, Steve Heimbecker and Aaron Byron. She paid \$32.60 to win.

A pair of OSS Grassroots divisions also went to gate for sophomore trotting fillies, with odds-on choice [Smashin Racquets](#) collecting the \$22,600 first split in 1:56. Driver Bob McClure sent the Rob Fellows pupil to the point through a :28 first quarter, slowed to a :58.3 half and endured first-over pressure from Lucy Who through three-quarters in 1:26.4 to then kick clear 3-1/2 lengths and win over pocket-sitter Its Your Choice. Lucy Who settled for third and Stonebridge Icing finished fourth. Awesome Acres Stbreds owns Smashin Racquets, a daughter of Resolve with three wins from 15 starts and \$42,751 on her card. She paid \$2.80 to win.

McClure came back in the other \$22,200 division to win going coast to coast with [Northern Charlotte](#) in 1:56.1. The Camilla Christoforou trainee vaulted from post seven to land on the helm to a :29.2 first quarter and strolled from there to a :59.2 half and 1:27.1 three-quarters. She repelled a first-over blitz from 33-1 No Angel Like Me to turn for home and hold 2-3/4 lengths on pocket-sitter Cardio Muscle in second, with Match Meif You Can third and HP Run For Dan fourth. Brad Grant owns the winning daughter of Muscle Mass who now has three wins from 10 starts and \$38,760 earned. She paid \$12.80 to win.

The undercard feature – a \$10,000 Preferred Handicap Pace – went to [Dylans Bank](#) in a pillar-to-post effort timed in 1:51. James MacDonald piloted the John MacMillan trainee as he survived a duel for the lead with Vanilla Malted through splits of :26, :54.4 and 1:23. As Vanilla Malted faltered, Dylans Bank accelerated into the stretch to win by 2-3/4 lengths over pocket-sitter Day Delight with Ima Dude third and Tuf Cooper closing for fourth. MacMillan owns the winning six-year-old gelding by Thinking Out Loud who paid \$11.40 to win.

T H McMurry Gives Taylor A Night To Remember



Last week Ontario's top two-year-old male pacers were at Woodbine Mohawk Park for two \$100,000-plus Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold divisions. That's business as usual at Ontario's premier racetrack, but for Jeff Taylor, the evening was anything but typical.

Taylor, a longtime industry participant, has 245 career training starts. The biggest purse in any of his own 10 training starts in 2023 was a \$22,000 OSS Grassroots division.

The purse in the first Gold division that night was \$103,100 and [T H McMurry](#), a gelding Taylor co-owns with Siobhan Andrusek and Graeme Mitchell, drew the eight-hole. From that outer post, he [paced a mile in 1:51.4 to win by a length](#) and give Taylor the biggest win of his life.

"I didn't know how to react to it, I was so happy, I couldn't believe it," said Taylor. "It's sunk in a little bit now and I feel really lucky to have an animal like him. I know how hard a lot of people work for a long time and some of them never get to this point. I'm just appreciating every minute because it's been so fun so far."

Those watching the Mohawk broadcast on July 10 heard the gelding's trainer Dave Menary praise Taylor, a Gloucester, Ont. resident, and his role in training down T H McMurry. But from Taylor's point of view, the win was a team effort.

“Dave’s done an excellent job,” said Taylor. “He had a great week [at Mohawk] in the Sires Stakes and I wouldn’t pick anybody else to trust him with. Dave’s been 100 per cent. He’s a class act.”



Bred by Tara Hills Stud and Brent Vincent, the road to T H McMurry’s Gold win began at the 2022 London Classic Yearling Sale. Taylor was attending with Mitchell and he had his eye on the son of McWicked after reviewing online videos prior to the sale. When he entered the ring as HIP 183, the bidding went to \$21,000 before stalling short of the \$22,000 Taylor signed for. A few days later, he sold 25 per cent each to Andrusek and Mitchell.

“I looked at the mare and I got looking at her record and what she did, and I thought, she’s got to throw something with the talent she had,” said Taylor. “I loved the look of the other McWicked in the sale and I put my hand up, I guess the rest of it’s kind of history.”

McWicked is a Hall of Fame racehorse who needs no introduction and T H McMurry’s dam Waasmula is a millionaire who won the 2011 OSS Super Final as a three-year-old.

So, he has pedigree, and when he shipped to Ottawa to begin his training to become a racehorse with Taylor, he showed he had the potential to follow in his parent’s footsteps.

“I gave him a day off and just put him in the paddock the first day he was here,” said Taylor. “The first day we put the harness on, I line drove him out the door. We put the cart on him and he was pacing walking up to the track. There was no bucking. There was no kicking. He walked up to the track, took a little look around, not out of panic or anything, and he just took off pacing.”

As T H McMurry continued to progress, Taylor found himself racing the youngster off a helmet as he trained his yearlings alongside Robbie Robinson's. But it didn't surprise Taylor that in his win T H McMurry cut the mile from the middle of the second quarter onward.

"Training, I liked to get him kind of in the middle of the back or on a helmet. I found he was a little racier off a helmet," said Taylor. "Then one day I cut the mile and he was a gentleman on the front. Nice hold on the bit, but when another horse came up to him, he wanted to hit another level. It was like he found a gear where it kind of surprised you. It brought a smile to your face."

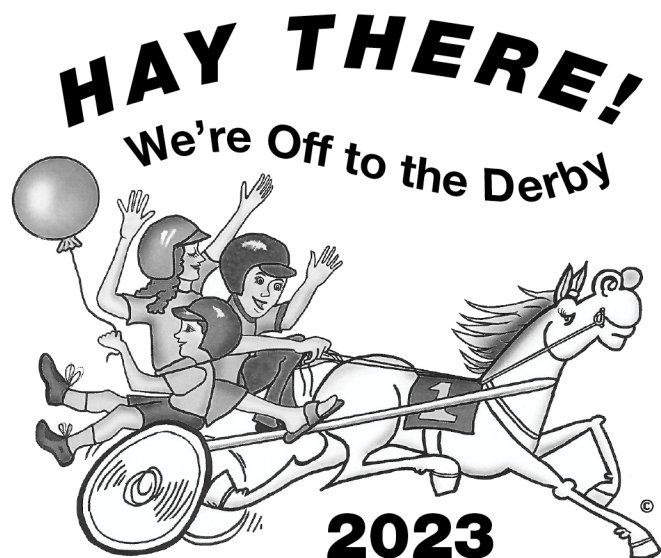
Taylor is a lifelong horseperson. His first exposure to racing was in his native province of Prince Edward Island through his grandfather Glen Taylor's horses, and continued with his father Kevin Taylor and his Uncle Kerry Taylor.

Then, nearly two decades ago, Taylor accepted a job working track maintenance at Rideau Carleton Raceway, a role he still holds today. It wasn't the job he envisioned in racing when he moved to Ontario, but it gave him stability as he raised young children.

Now his kids are more grown up and he has ramped up his involvement in the game. In racing, the horse of a lifetime can come at any moment, and for Taylor, with T H McMurry, that moment appears to be on the horizon.

"I feel really privileged for him to have done what he's done so far," said Taylor. "The number of calls, texts and messages I got... it was really humbling just how nice people were. I can't stress enough how much I appreciate all those kind words and everything."

Pari-mutuel wagering and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, an agency of the Ministry of Agriculture. All wagering pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Betting Regulations.

Rules and Information Regarding Canadian Harness and Foreign Separate Pool Events

General

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No person under the age 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher. A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty-four hours of buying or cashing valid ticket or voucher. No rules made by the judges or AGCO with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-outs or distributions of pari-mutuel pools. Program changes and e photo finishes pictures are shown on the televisions. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

Super Hi 5 Betting

A betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, the exact official order of finish in the race on which the feature is operated. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi feature.

Pick 4 and Pick 3

The Pick 4 and Pick 3 features are betting transactions in which the purchaser undertakes to select the winner of four or three successive races respectively. In the event selected horse is scratched, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch(es) occurred, will be substituted for the non starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non starting selection. **However, if a scratch occurs in any leg a Pick pool before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.**

Association Percentage and Taxation/Levy

Pick 4, Pick 5 & Super High 5 11.7%, Trifecta 21.95%, all other wagers 20.75%. Additionally, Ontario Provincial Levy 2% on all pools, except 4% trifecta pools. Ontario Government retains 0.5% on all bets. The Federal government through a revolving fund cost recovery basis retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control and audit services.

Federal Regulations Amendment

In the unlikely event that the prices are posted which are based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must immediately stop paying the erroneous prices, recalculate and pay the correct price including correction of all account-based wagers.

For wagers, no matter what the cause, which cannot be combined into the host track's pools before the end of the race; federal regulations require that such bets must be refunded.

Payment of wagers will be made only on the presentation of a valid pari-mutuel tickets.
