Ottawa becomes first Hard Rock International venue to implement award-winning *Women in Leadership* program

Ottawa, May 8, 2023 - Rideau Carleton Casino, Future Hard Rock is proud to be the first international Hard Rock location to implement the award-winning *Women in Leadership* program, which aims to increase women's representation within its leadership structure.

Since its introduction in 2016, more than 1,000 women have participated in the *Women in Leadership* program throughout Hard Rock International's U.S. properties. Through mentorship, education and networking, women in Director and Vice President roles in the Hard Rock International U.S. family have risen to 32 percent and 27 percent respectively, both of which are above the industry standard of 22 percent.

"The casino industry has traditionally been dominated by men, but as we position ourselves to become a major gaming and entertainment destination in the National Capital Region, we believe we can break that mould," says **Helen MacMillan**, General Manager, Rideau Carleton Casino, Future Hard Rock.

Last November, MacMillan was honoured with the prestigious Patricia Becker Pay It Forward Award on behalf of Global Gaming Women (GGW). It honours women who have demonstrated a commitment to the development and advancement of women in gaming, as well as in their community in general.

"Helping women advance in this industry is clearly very dear to my heart, which is why I am so proud to be part of an organization that truly values equity and inclusion" continued MacMillan. "I

am especially proud that Ottawa will be the first international Hard Rock property to introduce this important *Women In Leadership* program."

Hard Rock International recognized as top employer for women

Last year, Hard Rock International was again recognized by Forbes' list of America's Best Employers for Women within the Travel & Leisure category for the fifth year in a row.

Focus on female empowerment as Rideau Carleton Casino, Future Hard Rock gains momentum

Rideau Carleton Casino, Future Hard Rock currently employs 413 employees, 42 percent of them women. That employee base is expected to grow to more than 700 when the future Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Ottawa opens, making it a significant employer in the National Capital Region.

At a recent job fair, Rideau Carleton Casino, Future Hard Rock hired 133 new employees; a third of which were women.

"We were very excited to have so many women turn up, especially since they were applying for non-traditional roles like table games dealer," said MacMillan. "I believe it's a sign that our industry is changing, which is why it's all the more important to offer the tools to empower these women and enable them to take on more meaningful roles within the Hard Rock family."
